PRAYER TREE

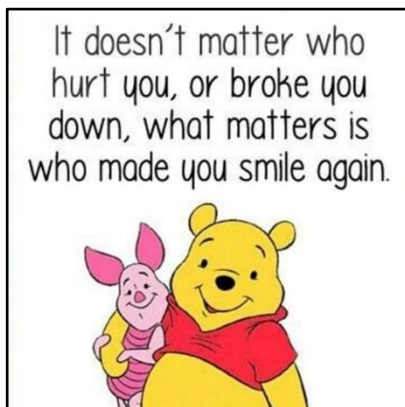
