Growing and Flourishing Together this Action for Children Sunday

We wish to appoint a Pastor to join our circuit team, to work alongside existing staff, Circuit Stewards & members in the leading and nurture of four churches and to assist the Circuit in developing discipleship. This is a new post within the Ministry Team of the Camborne, Redruth and Hayle Methodist Circuit, under the direction of the Superintendent Minister. The role is full-time (35 hours per week) and is initially for a period of 4 years. Part time may be considered.
