Passion News

There are rumours going around about the future of Passion, mostly incorrect. You will know initially the project was largely funded by the Church of England and since then we have relied on grants.

We are very grateful for those who give to us regularly because this funding has been vital to the project and we ask that you, please, continue to support us.

We are in a period of transition. The grants have come to an end and we are looking for new sources of funding. In the meantime we are stopping our work to reduce our costs while we secure the funds to continue.

We have a team of new volunteers with a vision for Passion's future. If you are able to financially support us with a donation, we desperately need your help. We need to raise a minimum of £6,000 by the end of the year for the rent, buildings insurance, electricity bill and other costs. We have an online fundraiser (please see below) and can accept cheques and cash.

Passion will be open for a table top sale, including home baked cakes and tea and coffee on Saturday 26 10am - 3pm and Sunday 27 October 11 - 4pm.

Donations of cakes for this event would be very gratefully received, thank you.

Passion still serves its original purpose of reducing antisocial behaviour in the town. We regularly have 30 young people on a Friday night and more as the weather gets worse. When told we were temporarily closing a 14 year old responded "We'd have nothing without this place".
